

The present CD continues our complete recording of Franz Schubert's chamber music for strings. The Leipzig String Quartet is heard in a performance of his mature Quartet in A minor D 804 and two new contributions to the Schubert discography and special treats for connoisseurs of classical music: the early work D 18 and the fragment D 470.

### Dear Rosamunde,...

The A minor quartet is full of hidden musical messages. Schubert viewed this key as a representation of "the fair sex" and dedicated the work as a whole to a woman who made a strong and lasting impression on him, the Cypriot queen Rosamunde.

# Hard to Believe but True

Schubert was an ardent admirer of Beethoven when he composed his G minor quartet at an age - thirteen - when most young people today are running after the latest pop idol.

## International Standard
