

## International Following

Schubert fans the world over have been following this first complete recording of his chamber music for strings and waiting impatiently for the release of Vol. 6 with the Leipzig String Quartet. The two String Quartets in B flat major (D 112 and 36) are two more splendid additions to this captivating audio contribution to Schubert research.

### **Teenage Genius**

Schubert's mature period and middle years began when he was only seventeen years old. The teenage genius was self-confident about the contributions he was making to music history and wrote with pride under the first movement "Finished in 4 1/2 hours."

#### Megastars

The beginning of Schubert's chamber oeuvre go back to his years at boarding school. It was in these Spartan circumstances that he composed emotionally profound, simply wonderful chamber works such as the fascinating Quartet D 36, the fifteen-year-old's homage to idols Haydn and Mozart and solid proof of his own genius.
