Double Culmination

The two compositions on this CD represent a double culmination: the musical language of a genius at the height of his compositional powers and the dazzling finale of the Leipzig String Quartet's world concert tour featuring these works.

Stumbling Block

A seven-movement string quartet? Beethoven's op. 131 has more than one riddle to it. His contemporaries could not quite understand his late quartets, and the deaf composer alluded to their stumbling in the motto of the finale of what turned out to be his last finished work, "Must it be?"

It must be!

The compositional innovations with which Beethoven challenged audiences and instrumentalists alike are comparable to the Schönbergian revolution of the early twentieth century. All the more reason for the Leipzig String Quartet to return to Beethoven, the supposed romanticist, following its acclaimed Schubert and Schönberg CD cycles!
