

Recipes for Success

With his Quartets op. 18/2 and op. 18/5 the genius Ludwig van Beethoven continued the successes that he had begun to celebrate in the genre of the string quartet only at the relatively ripe old age of twentynine. When the members of the Leipzig String Quartet were pushing thirty, they were already acclaimed interpreters in the same genre. Their recipe for success rests on their extraordinary careful preparation of their international concert performances.

Public Spotlight

Beethoven also knew why he had to do his homework when it came to the string quartet. Vienna was a hardto-please, highly competitive place where a composer could make a favorable impression only with firstclass achievements. So at first, master of keyboard interpretation and improvisation that he was, he dared to exhibit only his piano music in the full glaring public spotlight.

Take a Bow

Etymological folk tradition in the music world often formulates unusual nicknames for its favorite works. Beethoven's Quartet op. 18/2 came to be known as the "Compliment Quartet" not because the public suddenly took the eccentric Beethoven for a polite gentleman but because the musical language of the quartet seems to consist of countless little bows.
