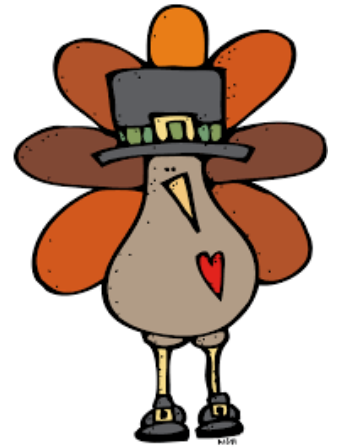


Newsletter for the Weeks of November 11-15, 2024

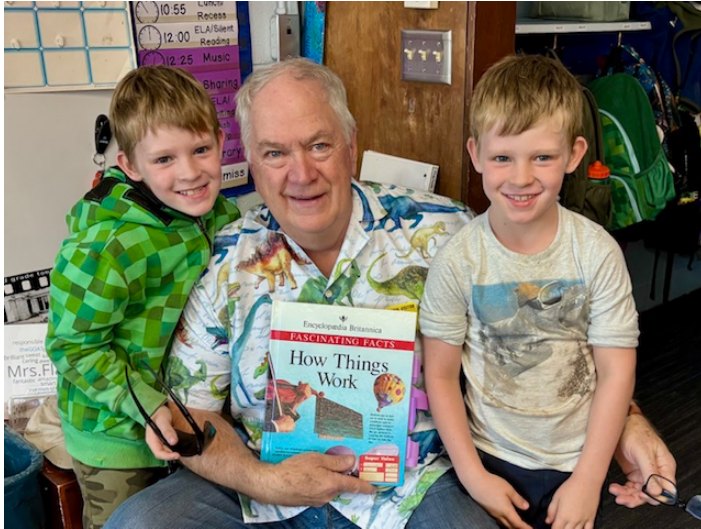
GLS Elementary K-5 Service Project
