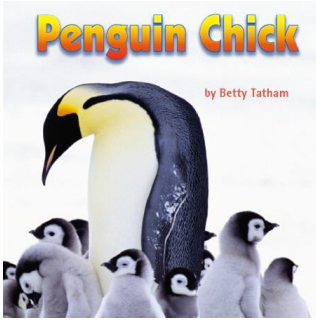
3rd Quarter BOOK REPORTS

Vocabulary Strategy: Using a dictionary

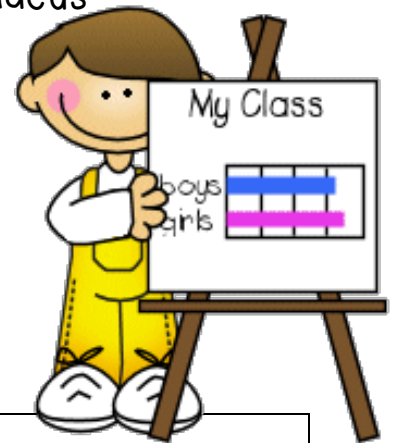
Comprehension Skill:
