Thursday, March 6<sup>th</sup>: Cat in the Hat (wear a hat)

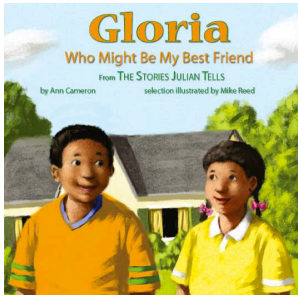
Friday, March 7<sup>th</sup>: Oh the Places You'll Go
