Comprehension Strategy: Question — ask questions about what you are reading

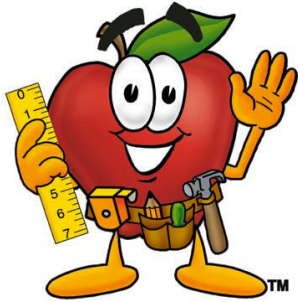
