The DRA 3 is given one-on-one. This assessment uses oral reading accuracy, fluency, and comprehension to determine the student's independent reading level.

The Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) is a computer-adaptive assessment that measures a student's reading proficiency based on the complexity of the text he or she can read and comprehend. This is the student's Lexile.
